**O R D E R**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On March 7, 2003 BC Gas Utility Ltd., now known as Terasen Gas Inc. ("Terasen Gas"), applied to the Commission for approval of Amended and Restated Bypass Transportation Agreements with Canadian Forest Products Ltd. (Prince George Pulp), West Fraser Mills, Canadian Forest Products (Northwood Pulp), Cariboo Pulp Company, Husky Oil Operations Limited, and Tembec Industries Inc. (Chetwynd Division). Terasen Gas also applied to cancel the corresponding predecessor Tariff Supplements with the above-noted customers; and
- B. On May 2, 2003, Terasen Gas filed a number of revisions to documents contained in the March 7, 2003 application along with revised index pages; and
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that the amended and restated Tariff Supplements are in the public interest.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Commission approves for Terasen Gas, Amended and Restated Bypass Transportation Agreements as Rate Schedule 22A Tariff Supplements, and the cancellation of predecessor Tariff Supplements for the following customers:

- Canadian Forest Products Ltd. (Prince George Pulp) - Tariff Supplement G-5
- West Fraser Mills - Tariff Supplement G-6
- Canadian Forest Products (Northwood Pulp) - Tariff Supplement G-7
- Cariboo Pulp Company - Tariff Supplement G-8
- Husky Oil Operations Limited - Tariff Supplement G-9
- Tembec Industries Inc. (Chetwynd Division) - Tariff Supplement G-13

The Approval of the foregoing Tariff Supplements and the cancellation of the predecessor Tariff Supplements are effective November 1, 1993.
