Re: Terasen Gas Inc. ("Terasen Gas") Second Quarter 2003 Report Revelstoke Propane Costs Deferral Account

Terasen Gas' Second Quarter 2003 Report dated June 9, 2003 indicates that the Revelstoke Propane Deferral Account is in a credit balance and a rate change is not required. The Commission notes that Terasen Gas intends to implement a propane price risk management plan over the next two months and once a fixed price for winter consumption has been established, the impact on rates will be more certain in the next quarter. Therefore, the Commission accepts Terasen Gas' recommendation that propane rates remain unchanged at this time.
