ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On June 3, 2004, ES (B.C.) Limited Partnership ("ES") applied to the Commission for a Gas Marketer Licence. The application included the payment of the \$1,000 application fee and a \$250,000 Letter of Credit pursuant to the requirements of Item 3 of the Licence application form; and
- B. The Commission has reviewed ES' application and relying upon the information and representations made by ES, finds that approval of the Gas Marketer Licence, subject to conditions, is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 71.1(6) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission issues to ES, carrying on business in the Province of British Columbia under the name Energy Savings B.C., a Gas Marketer Licence for the period April 29, 2004 to October 31, 2005.
- 2. The Licence is subject to the following conditions:
 - 2.1 ES will carry out the undertakings as set out in the application for a Licence to Market Natural Gas and the Rules for Gas Marketers.
 - 2.2 ES will comply with the Code of Conduct for Gas Marketers and Rate Schedule 36 of Terasen Gas Inc.
 - 2.3 ES will maintain a Letter of Credit or acceptable substitute in full force and effect for the duration of the Licence.
 - 2.4 ES will maintain a Working Capital position of at least \$50,000 and a Current Ratio of current assets to current liabilities of at least 1.10.
