#### ORDER

### **WHEREAS:**

- A. On December 21, 2004, Princeton Light and Power Company, Limited ("PLP") applied to the Commission for approval to pass-through increased power purchase costs from its supplier FortisBC Inc. ("FortisBC"), effective January 1, 2005 ("the Application"); and
- B. Commission Order No. G-111-04 approved an interim rate increase of 3.7 percent for FortisBC, effective January 1, 2005; and
- C. The Application requests a 3.7 percent increase to the energy component of rates for all customers, effective January 1, 2005.

## **NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 61(4) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission approves for PLP, effective January 1, 2005, a 3.7 percent interim increase to the energy component of rates for all customers.
- 2. The interim increase is subject to refund with interest calculated at the average prime rate of the principal bank with which PLP conducts its business. The final rate determination will be made by way of a future Commission Order following the Commission's Decision on FortisBC's 2005 Revenue Requirements.
- 3. PLP is directed to provide all customers with information on the rates resulting from the pass-through of increased power purchase costs from FortisBC.
