WHEREAS:

- A. On August 5, 2005 Avista Energy Canada Ltd. ("Avista") applied to the Commission for a Gas Marketer Licence. The application included the payment of the \$1,000 application fee; and
- B. On November 1, 2005 the Commission received Avista's \$250,000 Letter of Credit, pursuant to the requirements of Item 3 of the Licence application form; and

C. The Commission finds that approval of a Gas Marketer Licence, subject to conditions, is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to section 71.1(6) of the Utilities Commission Act, the Commission orders as follows:

- 1. The Commission issues to Avista, a Gas Marketer Licence for the period November 1, 2005 to October 31, 2006.
- 2. The Licence is subject to the following conditions:
 - 2.1 Avista will carry out the undertakings as set out in the application dated August 5, 2005 for a Gas Marketer Licence to market natural gas and the Rules for Gas Marketers.

- 2.2 Avista will comply with the Code of Conduct for Gas Marketers and Rate Schedule 36 of Terasen Gas Inc.
- 2.3 Avista will maintain a Letter of Credit or acceptable substitute in full force and effect for the duration of the Licence.
- 2.4 Avista will maintain a Working Capital position of at least \$50,000 and a Current Ratio of current assets to current liabilities of at least 1.10.
- 2.5 The Commission may, at any time and without prior notice to Avista, withdraw the Gas Marketer Licence for reasons the Commission, in its sole discretion, deems and considers sufficient.
- 2.6 The Gas Marketer Licence and all copies of it shall remain the property of the Commission and Avista will return these documents forthwith upon written request from the Commission.
