ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. The Commission by Order No. P-6-97 approved for Federated Pipe Lines (Western) Ltd., now known as Pembina Pipeline Corporation ("Pembina") annual tolls on its Sunset Prairie Crude Oil Pipeline pursuant to a ten-year agreement with its Shipper, Imperial Oil Resources, now known as Duvernay Oil Corporation ("Duvernay"); and
- B. On October 9, 2003 the Commission, by Order No. P-2-03, approved 2003/04 tolls by Tariff No. S-07 for the Sunset Prairie Crude Oil Pipeline of \$29,897 per month effective July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004; and
- C. On December 20, 2004, Pembina applied to the Commission to continue the tolls contained in Tariff No. S-07 that was approved in Order No. P-2-03, effective July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005, on its crude oil pipeline from the Sunset Prairie Battery to a tie-in point with its Taylor to Kamloops crude oil pipeline; and
- D. The sole shipper, Duvernay, by letter dated January 19, 2005, informed the Commission of its agreement to continue the tolls approved in Order No. P-2-03, effective July 1, 2004. Duvernay's letter of support was received by the Commission on February 4, 2005; and
- E. The Commission has considered the Application and finds that approval is required.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 44 of the Pipeline Act, the tolls approved by Order No. P-2-03 and Tariff No. S-07 will continue for the Sunset Prairie Pipeline, effective July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005. The approved tolls are subject to review by the Commission following receipt of a complaint by Duvernay or prospective shippers on the pipeline.
