- A. The British Columbia Utilities Commission (the "Commission") by Order G-157-08 dated October 24, 2008, accepted the findings and recommendations of the Inquiry Report filed by Mr. W. J. Grant on October 28, 2008; and
- B. Pursuant to the Code of Conduct for Gas Marketers, the Commission cancelled the Agreement between Universal Energy Corporation ("Universal Energy") and Mrs. Kitchen on the same basis as if the cancellation had occurred during the normal ten day cancellation period and ordered the costs of the Commission in the amount of \$4,990.90 incurred for the services of the Inquiry Officer to be recovered from Universal Energy; and
- C. By letter dated December 8, 2008, Universal Energy filed with the Commission a request for a review of Order G-157-08 ("Reconsideration Application") citing error in findings and fact; and
- D. Universal Energy seeks a reconsideration of the Order based on evidence that the Inquiry was carried out in a manner that contravened a basic requirement of procedural fairness and the Inquiry Officer exceeded the proper scope of his mandate; and

E. The Commission Panel has reviewed the Reconsideration Application by Universal Energy and the criteria regarding the reasonable basis for allowing reconsideration, and has concluded that the request for reconsideration should proceed.
