- A. On April 12, 2011, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) filed an application to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) under sections 58-61 of the Utilities Commission Act seeking approval to amend certain Tariff schedules and terms and conditions for Rate Schedules (RS) 1702 and RS 1704 (the Application);
