ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) Order G-67-09 required entities subject to approved Mandatory Reliability Standards to file Mitigation Plans outlining how they plan to meet compliance with standards they were not in compliance with;
- B. The Compliance Monitoring Program approved by Order G-123-09 requires that an entity file a Mitigation Plan for every violation of a standard. The Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) as the Commission's program administrator, reviews the Mitigation Plan and makes a recommendation to the Commission;
- C. By Order G-152-10, the Commission approved the Mitigation Plan filed by British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority for CIP-002-1 R1, R2, R3 and R4.
- D. On August 26, 2011, WECC recommended the Commission approve for British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority an Attestation of Mitigation Plan Completion for CIP-002-1 R1, R2, R3 and R4.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 125.2 (10) of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the Commission accepts the WECC recommendation and approves the Attestation of Mitigation Plan Completion as listed above.
