## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On March 30, 2012, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission), pursuant to section 50(2) of the *Utilities Commission Act* (the Act), for approval to issue common shares for \$65 million in order to maintain FEI's Commission-approved equity percentage (the Application);
- B. FEI states that the equity injection is necessary as a result of various capital projects, including the Customer Care Enhancement (CCE) Project and the in-sourcing of a new customer information system approved by Commission Order C-1-10, which went into service January 1, 2012, with an estimated cost of \$110 million including allowance for funds used during construction. FEI further states that this issuance is necessary in order to remain in compliance with Commission Order G-49-07, which approved the Fortis Inc. acquisition of the issued and outstanding shares of FortisBC Holdings Inc. (then Terasen Inc.) and related ring-fencing conditions in Commission Orders G-116-05, G-75-06 and Letter L-30-06 issued in the prior acquisition of the issued and outstanding shares of FortisBC Holdings Inc. by Kinder Morgan, Inc.;
- C. The Commission has reviewed the Application and finds that approval is warranted.
