## WHEREAS:

A. Section 125.2 of the Utilities Commission Act (Act) assigns exclusive jurisdiction to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) to determine whether a "reliability standard," as defined in the Act, is in the public interest and should be adopted in British Columbia. By Order G-123-09, the Commission approved the Compliance Monitoring Program (CMP) for monitoring and enforcement of adopted reliability standards and appointed the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC) as its Administrator for registration and monitoring compliance as per section 8 of the Act;

ORDER

- B. Commission Order G-67-09 requires entities subject to approved Mandatory Reliability Standards to file mitigation plans outlining how they plan to achieve compliance;
- C. Pursuant to Section 5.3 of the CMP, a Mitigation Plan with respect to an Alleged Violation may be submitted at any time, and a Mitigation Plan with respect to a Confirmed Violation must be submitted within ten business days following confirmation by the Commission;
- D. On July 23, 2012, Toba Montrose General Partnership (TMGP) submitted Mitigation Plans to address the possible or alleged violations of Reliability Standards PER-002-0R3 and R4 and PER-003-0 R1. The proposed completion date for the Mitigation Plans was December 31, 2011;
- E. By letters dated September 5, 2012, WECC recommended acceptance of the following Mitigation Plans to bring TMGP into compliance with the standards identified below:
