**O R D E R**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On November 28, 2014, Creative Energy Vancouver Platforms Inc. (Creative Energy) filed its 2015-2017 Revenue Requirements Application (Application) with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission);
- B. By Order G-198-14, the Commission established the regulatory timetable for review of the Application, which included a single round of information requests (IRs);
- C. The regulatory timetable was further amended in Order G-33-15 to include a second round of IRs;
- D. By the Commission's letter dated March 27, 2015, the remainder of the regulatory timetable was suspended subject to further consideration by the Commission; and
- E. The Commission now considers it necessary to lift the suspension and to finalize the remainder of the regulatory timetable to accommodate the final submissions from all parties.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Commission orders as follows:
