## ORDER

## WHEREAS:

- A. On February 7, 2014, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of FEI Tariff Supplement J-3, including the rate design and the rates established in the Permanent Refueling Agreement and subsequent Amending Agreements between Vedder Transport Ltd. (Vedder) and FEI on a permanent basis, effective January 1, 2013. On February 27, 2014, pursuant to Order G-22-14, the Commission approved the Vedder rates on a permanent basis;
- B. On April 1, 2014, FEI and Wheeler Transport Ltd. (Wheeler) executed a Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Fueling Services Agreement whereby Wheeler would be permitted to receive LNG from the Vedder fueling station (Wheeler from Vedder Agreement);
- C. On May 16, 2014, FEI applied for interim and permanent approval of the rates and contract for service established in the Wheeler from Vedder Agreement, effective April 1, 2014 (Application);
- D. On June 3, 2014, the Commission issued Order G-69-14, pursuant to sections 59-61 and 89 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, approving rates established in the Wheeler from Vedder Agreement for LNG fueling service from the Vedder fueling station on an interim basis, effective April 1, 2014;
- E. On April 6, 2015, FEI and Wheeler entered into an Amending Agreement to align the effective date of rate escalation with the rate escalation date applicable to the Vedder fueling station, which is January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year;
- F. On May 8, 2015, FEI filed an updated Tariff Supplement J-11 to reflect the January 1<sup>st</sup> rate escalation date amendment to the Wheeler from Vedder Agreement effective April 1, 2014; and

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G. The Commission has reviewed and considered the Application and determines the interim rates should be approved as permanent.

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to sections 59-61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the Commission orders that the rates and contract for Liquefied Natural Gas Supply from the Vedder Transport Ltd. fueling station for Wheeler Transport Ltd. are approved on a permanent basis, effective April 1, 2014.
