ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On July 28, 2016 pursuant to Order G-122-16, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (Commission) established the regulatory timetable for the FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) Annual Review for 2017 Delivery Rates proceeding, which included the anticipated date for FEI to file its annual review materials, intervener registration, one round of information requests, a workshop, FEI's response to workshop undertakings, and written final and reply arguments;
- B. On August 2, 2016, FEI submitted its Annual Review for 2017 Delivery Rates materials (Application);
- C. The following participants filed Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) applications with the Commission with respect to their participation in the proceeding:
