## **ORDER**

## WHEREAS:

- A. On November 18, 2019, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC), pursuant to sections 59 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, for approval of the Revenue Stabilization Adjustment Mechanism (RSAM) and Biomethane Variance Account (BVA) rate riders, on a permanent basis effective January 1, 2020 (Application);
- B. The Application seeks approval to set the BVA rate rider for 2020 in the amount of \$0.019 per gigajoule (GJ) and to set the RSAM rate rider for 2020 in the amount of \$0.078 per GJ; and
- C. The BCUC has completed its review of the Application and finds that approval is warranted.

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to sections 59 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. The BVA rate rider, effective January 1, 2020, in the amount of \$0.019 per GJ for applicable rate schedules is approved.
- 2. The RSAM rate rider, effective January 1, 2020 in the amount of \$0.078 per GJ for applicable rate schedules is approved.
- 3. FEI is directed to file revised tariff pages with the BCUC within 15 days of this order.
