## ORDER NUMBER G-172-22

IN THE MATTER OF the *Utilities Commission Act*, RSBC 1996, Chapter 473

and

British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority
Request for Approval to Rescind Electric Tariff Supplement No. 58

## **ORDER**

## **WHEREAS:**

- A. On June 8, 2022, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) filed an application, pursuant to sections 58 to 61 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA) to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC), requesting to rescind Electric Tariff Supplement No. 58 (TS 58) (Application);
- B. By Order G-63-01, dated June 14, 2001, the BCUC approved TS 58 to be effective for 20 years, commencing July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2021;
- C. By Order G-199-21, dated June 28, 2021, the BCUC approved Richmond Plywood Corporation Ltd. (Richply)'s request for an eight-month extension of TS 58, expiring on February 28, 2022;
- D. On February 7, 2022, BC Hydro filed an application seeking approval of a new version of its Electric Tariff Supplement for service to Richply;
- E. By Order G-54-22, dated February 22, 2022, the BCUC approved a subsequent extension request to allow TS 58 to continue to be in effect until such time as the BCUC rendered its final determination on the matter;
- F. By Order G-125-22, dated May 9, 2022, the BCUC approved TS 102 for a 10-year term and directed BC Hydro to refile TS 102 for endorsement;
- G. On June 8, 2022, BC Hydro filed a compliance filing in accordance with Directive 3 of Order G-125-22 for TS 102 to be endorsed by the BCUC and returned to BC Hydro. TS 102 has an effective date of May 27, 2022;
- H. TS 58 is no longer required as it is replaced with TS 102; and
- The BCUC has reviewed the Application and determines that consenting to the rescindment of TS 58, is warranted.

Final Order 1 of 2

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to section 61 of the UCA, the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. TS 58 is rescinded, effective May 26, 2022.
- 2. Tariff pages as filed in Attachment 3 of the application are accepted for filing.
