#### **ORDER**

#### WHEREAS:

- A. On December 17, 2021, in accordance with British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) Orders G-35-21 and G-242-21, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) filed its Stage 2 Comprehensive Review and Application for Approval of a Revised Renewable Gas Program (Application);
- B. By Orders G-3-22, G-103-22 and G-165-22A, the BCUC established a regulatory timetable for the Application, including, among other items, the timelines for intervener written final arguments of May 18, 2023 and FEI written reply argument of June 5, 2023;
- C. By letter dated January 30, 2023, the Metro Vancouver Regional District (Metro Vancouver) filed a request for a two-week extension to the filing deadline of intervener written final arguments, as established by Order G-165-22A. Metro Vancouver indicates that the submission of its final arguments requires approvals from its Climate Action Committee and Board of Directors, which have meetings scheduled for May 11, 2023 and May 28, 2023, respectively;
- D. By letter dated February 2, 2023, BCUC invited FEI and other interveners to provide submissions, if any, on Metro Vancouver's extension request and certain date amendments to the regulatory timetable. The BCUC received a submission from FEI and nine submissions from interveners, none of whom expressed objections to Metro Vancouver's extension request;
- E. In its letter dated February 6, 2023, FEI requests a time gap of at least three weeks between the deadline for interveners' written final arguments and FEI's written reply argument, due to the number of interveners as well as the volume and complexity of the evidentiary record; and
- F. The BCUC has reviewed Metro Vancouver's extension request and the submissions received and determines that an amendment to the regulatory timetable is warranted.
