ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On December 20, 2019, by Order G-341-19, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) established a written public hearing for the review of a proposed regulatory framework for Thermal Energy Systems (TES Review);
- B. The following intervener filed an Interim Participant Assistance/Cost Award (PACA) application with the BCUC with respect to their participation in the proceeding:

- C. BCSEA submits that the long duration of the proceeding warrants the awarding of interim costs to BCSEA; and
- D. The BCUC has reviewed the Interim PACA application in accordance with the criteria and rates set out in the PACA Guidelines, attached to BCUC Order G-97-17, and concludes that an adjusted cost award should be approved.
