1   **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

2   This submission by FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) sets out the proposed Annual Contracting Plan  
3   (ACP) that is designed to meet the forecast propane supply requirements for Revelstoke  
4   customers for the period from November 1, 2023 to October 31, 2024 (2023/24 ACP). The  
5   primary objective of the 2023/24 ACP is to provide secure, reliable, and cost-effective supply to  
6   meet the requirements of Revelstoke customers.

7   The estimated propane supply for Revelstoke is approximately 10,500 cubic metres (M<sup>3</sup>) for the  
8   2023/24 year. FEI has two contracts in place to source and deliver propane from Alberta to  
9   Revelstoke upon request. Both contracts expire on March 31, 2024, and FEI recommends to  
10   renew existing contracts for another two-year term from April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2026.

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
