ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On August 29, 2023, FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) pursuant to section 23(1)(g) of the *Utilities Commission Act* for approval of an operating agreement, dated August 20, 2023, entered into between the City of Quesnel and FEI, effective January 1, 2024 (FEI-Quesnel Operating Agreement) (Application);
- B. By Order C-16-03, dated December 1, 2003, the BCUC approved the current operating agreement between FEI (through its predecessor company Terasen Gas Inc.) and the City of Quesnel. The term of the current operating agreement expires on December 31, 2023;
- C. By Order G-269-23, dated October 12, 2023, the BCUC established a public hearing process and a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application, which included public notice, intervenor registration and letters of comment. The regulatory timetable established the deadline for intervenor registration and letters of comment as November 7, 2023;
- D. By November 7, 2023, no intervenor registration requests or letters of comment were received by the BCUC;
- E. By letter dated November 9, 2023, FEI submits that as no letters of comment have been filed, no further process is required and the Application should be approved on a permanent basis; and
- F. The BCUC has reviewed the Application and determines that approval is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 23(1)(g) of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the BCUC orders that the FEI-Quesnel Operating Agreement is approved on a permanent basis, effective January 1, 2024.
