ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On March 17, 2023, British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) filed an application with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) seeking to amend the Major Capital Project Filing Guidelines (Application);
- B. On December 2, 2019, by Order G-313-19, the BCUC approved the 2018 Major Capital Project Filing Guidelines (2018 Guidelines), including BC Hydro's commitment to submit applications to the BCUC for major capital projects with authorized cost estimates that exceed the following thresholds:
 - 1. \$100 million for power system projects;
 - 2. \$50 million for buildings projects; and
 - 3. \$20 million for information technology projects.
- C. By Order G-113-23, dated May 9, 2023, the BCUC established a regulatory timetable for review of the Application. By Orders G-118-23, dated May 17, 2023, G-132-23, dated June 7, 2023, and G-184-23, dated July 13, 2023, respectively, the BCUC amended the regulatory timetable;
- D. By letter dated July 18, 2023, BC Hydro requested that the BCUC hold in abeyance BC Hydro's request for BCUC approval in relation to the Customer IPID 901943 Project. By letter dated July 25, 2023, the BCUC granted BC Hydro's abeyance request;
- E. In its response to BCUC and intervener IR No. 1 dated September 22, 2023, BC Hydro requested that its submission in the Application seeking to increase the capital project thresholds be placed in abeyance pending a further filing by BC Hydro in February, 2024 following the conclusion of its 10-year capital planning process;

- F. On October 31, 2023, by Order G-296-23, the BCUC established a further regulatory timetable which included a Streamlined Review Process set for November 23, 2023 regarding the proposed amendments to project reporting guidelines, and the participants' final and reply arguments regarding same;
- G. By Order G-27-24A, dated January 31, 2024, the BCUC issued its decision on amended guidelines for project reporting;
- H. On February 23, 2024, in accordance with the regulatory timetable, BC Hydro filed its revised application (Revised Application). In the Revised Application, BC Hydro seeks the following approvals:
 - An increase to the major project expenditure thresholds to:
 - \$250 million for power system projects;
 - \$125 million for building projects; and
 - \$50 million for information technology projects.
 - To clarify the definition of "extension;"
 - To update the annual reporting requirements in the 2018 Guidelines to reflect the BCUC's direction in letter L-46-23;
 - To withdraw the following applications that had previously been held in abeyance:
 - To escalate the capital expenditure thresholds in accordance with an applicable price index;
 and
 - That the BCUC confirm that an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) is not required for the Customer IPID – 901943 Project; and
- I. The BCUC has commenced its review of the Revised Application and finds that the following determinations are warranted.

NOW THEREFORE the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. As soon as practicable, but no later than Friday, March 8, 2024, BC Hydro must publish the Public Notice, attached as Appendix B to this order, on its website and social media platforms. It must also publish weekly reminder notices on each platform until the conclusion of the intervener registration period on Tuesday, April 9, 2024.
- 2. BC Hydro is directed to provide an electronic copy of the Revised Application and this order on or before Friday, March 8, 2024, to all known affected or potentially affected parties, including registered interveners in the BC Hydro F2023 F2025 Revenue Requirements proceeding and potentially affected Indigenous groups.
- 3. BC Hydro is directed to provide to the BCUC, by Wednesday, March 13, 2024, confirmation of when the Public Notice has been posted, including a list of the platforms on which the Public Notice was posted.

- 4. BC Hydro is directed to provide to the BCUC, by Wednesday, March 13, 2024, a list of all parties directly notified of the Revised Application and this order, including the method and date of notification.
- 5. BC Hydro is directed to file the further information as requested in Appendix C to this order, by Wednesday, March 13, 2024.
- 6. Persons who wish to register as an intervener must do so by Tuesday, April 9, 2024.
- 7. BC Hydro's previous applications for BCUC approval of the following requests are dismissed:
 - o To escalate the capital expenditure thresholds in accordance with an applicable price index; and
 - That the BCUC confirm that an application for a CPCN is not required for the Customer IPID 901943 Project.

BC HYDRO'S REQUEST TO AMEND MAJOR CAPITAL PROJECT FILING GUIDELINES

On February 23, 2024, BC Hydro requested an increase in the expenditure thresholds above which BC Hydro must file an application for BCUC approval of major capital projects. As a result, projects with capital budgets above the existing thresholds, but below the proposed thresholds, would no longer be reviewed separately by the BCUC. The interests of certain parties may be affected. The expenditure thresholds BC Hydro proposes are:

- \$250 million for power system projects (increased from \$100 million);
- \$125 million for building projects (increased from \$50 million); and
- \$50 million for information technology projects (increased from \$20 million).

 - Uncertainties to monitor;
 - A discussion of investments in each subsector including power system (dam safety, generation stations, substations, transmission, distribution, protection & control and telecom), technology, properties, fleet services;
 - Resources and execution of the plan; and
 - Appendices containing tables of expenditures and additions by year, list of projects greater than \$50M with forecast in service dates and latest forecast cost amounts.
- 2) Please update the list of projects provided in Appendix C to Exhibit B-14 to include all projects with an estimated cost range greater than \$50M and all exempt projects.
- 3) Using the proposed major project thresholds and the information in Table 8 on page 11 of Exhibit B-14, please complete the following table, for each year of the BC Hydro 10 year capital forecast. Please duplicate the table to provide a response under each of i) the proposed expenditure thresholds; and ii) the existing expenditure thresholds.
