WHEREAS:

On March 5, 2024, BC Hydro filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for Off-Grid Electric Vehicle Charging Stations (Application);

- A. In the Application, pursuant to sections 45 and 46 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (UCA), BC Hydro seeks the issuance of a CPCN for BC Hydro to construct and operate three electric vehicle charging stations that are outside of BC Hydro's integrated area and non-integrated areas in northern B.C. at the following locations: Tetsa River Lodge; Liard Hot Springs Lodge; and Bell 2 Lodge; and
- B. The BCUC determines establishing a regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. A written public hearing is established for the review of the Application in accordance with the regulatory timetable set out in Appendix A to this order.
- 2. BC Hydro is directed to provide a copy of this order and the Application to parties in the BC Hydro Public Electric Vehicle Charging Service Rates proceeding and to local First Nation communities by Thursday, March 28, 2024.
