1 **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

2 This submission by FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) sets out the proposed Annual Contracting Plan
3 (ACP) that is designed to meet the forecast propane supply requirements for Revelstoke
4 customers for the period from November 1, 2024 to October 31, 2025 (2024/25 ACP). The
5 primary objective of the 2024/25 ACP is to provide secure, reliable, and cost-effective supply to
6 meet the requirements of Revelstoke customers.

7 Revelstoke propany supply requirements for the 2024/25 year are approximately 11,500 cubic
8 metres (M³). FEI renewed the propane supply and delivery contracts in March 2024, and the
9 executed contracts have been filed and accepted by the BCUC.

10
