1 **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

2 This submission by FortisBC Energy Inc. (FEI) sets out the proposed Annual Contracting Plan
3 (ACP) that is designed to meet the forecast propane supply requirements for Revelstoke
4 customers for the period from November 1, 2025 to October 31, 2026 (2025/26 ACP). The primary
5 objective of the 2025/26 ACP is to provide secure, reliable, and cost-effective supply to meet the
6 requirements of Revelstoke customers.

7 Revelstoke propane supply requirements for the 2025/26 year are approximately 13,000 cubic
8 metres (M³). FEI has two contracts in place to source and deliver propane from Alberta to
9 Revelstoke upon request. Both contracts expire on March 31, 2026, and FEI recommends to
10 renew existing contracts for another two-year term from April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2028.
