**Re: Easy Energy Inc. – A-5-24 Amendment to Consumer Agreement**

Dear Mr. Dixon:

On July 15, 2025, Easy Energy Inc. (Easy Energy) filed a copy of its updated consumer agreement with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC), pursuant to the condition on Easy Energy's gas marketer licence set out in Directive 3(e)(ii) of Order A-5-24, issued by the BCUC on October 31, 2024. Directive 3(e)(ii) states:

3. This Gas Marketer Licence is subject to the following conditions:

... e. Pursuant to section 10 of the Rules, in order to maintain compliance with Licence Requirements, the following information must be submitted to the BCUC for review and approval, as it becomes available:

... ii. The most recent version of the documents submitted under Sections 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the Licence Requirements prior to use.

Consumer's agreements must be submitted to the BCUC pursuant to section 10 of the Licence Requirements included as Attachment 1 to the Rules for Gas Marketers.

Easy Energy explains that the first page of the agreement was amended (Amendment) to include in Section 4 ("HELPFUL INFORMATION") the following text: "**VERIFICATION REQUIRED:** You will receive a call and/or text/SMS message to verify this Agreement before we can submit your enrollment to FortisBC."

**The Panel has reviewed and approves the Amendment.**
