On August 27, 2025, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) received your request for capacity funding to support kʷikʷəłəm First Nation's participation in the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority's (BC Hydro) Waste to Energy Facility 2025 Electricity Purchase Agreement Renewal proceeding.

Based on the nature and timeliness of your request, the BCUC grants kʷikʷəłəm First Nation capacity funding up to \$1,500 to support its review of the relevant proceeding documents and the potential submission of a Letter of Comment.
