ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On March 4, 2026, Pacific Northern Gas Ltd. and Pacific Northern Gas (N.E.) Ltd. (collectively, PNG) filed a letter with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) requesting a further extension of time to submit the compliance filing required pursuant to Directive 3 of Order G-55-25 regarding PNG's 2024 Consolidated Resource Plan (Second Extension Request);
- B. Directive 3 of Order G-55-25 directed PNG to provide in a compliance filing, no later than December 31, 2025, further information regarding its resiliency risks as detailed in Section 2.5 of the decision accompanying Order G-55-25 (Compliance Filing);
- C. By letter dated January 5, 2026, PNG submitted an initial request to extend the deadline for submitting the Compliance Filing, from December 31, 2025, to March 6, 2026. The BCUC approved this extension request by Order G-2-26 dated January 12, 2026;
- D. In the Second Extension Request, PNG explains that additional time is necessary due to several factors that have affected the ability to complete the Compliance Filing by the March 6, 2026 deadline, including elevated regulatory and operational workloads, periods of reduced staff availability and other internal resource constraints. PNG requests a further extension to March 27, 2026, to allow sufficient time for finalization and review of the Compliance Filing; and
- E. The BCUC has reviewed the Second Extension Request and considers the following determination is warranted.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 99 of the *Utilities Commission Act*, the BCUC orders the Compliance Filing deadline is extended from March 6, 2026, to March 27, 2026.
